Dear singers, parents, and friends,

Welcome to our 35th Newsletter for Y.E.S!

After meeting with Fr. Darren and studying the guidelines for a safe return to singing in churches, we have decided to take the first carefully considered steps to bringing **Y.E.S!** back to rehearse and sing in church. It will feel very different, we understand that, but within these guidelines, we are hoping to recapture some of the joy of singing together in church that has made **Y.E.S!** such an inspirational group of young singers.

We will be continuing with our vocal training and learning music for an **All-Age service on 22**nd **November and a Family Carol Service on 19**th **December**. If it is safe to do so, it may be possible to arrange some ribbon training sessions for small groups, but we will review this in November. Jill will arrange individual sessions for Dean's and Bishop's Chorister training.

Please read the following instructions very carefully, and **if you feel you are willing for your child to return to singing in church under these conditions, please let Jill know immediately**. We are sorry that numbers have to be limited and planned for, and we cannot allow people just to turn up or not on the day.

- A chorister can only attend the rehearsals if a parent has informed the Director of Music that they wish to return by half-term. Commitment is essential please.
- Please arrive promptly, but no earlier than 5.55pm. Once we know the numbers involved, some of you may be asked to enter through a different door.
- Parents will not be allowed into the building for rehearsals, only for services.
- Choristers should sanitise their hands on entering church and wait to be shown their allocated seat.
- Choristers must stay in that seat and not sit in any of the pews or move around the church unless asked to do so. There must be no running in the church.
- Choristers will have a folder for music. Music cannot be shared and must be left in a box at the end of the rehearsal.
- There will be no toilet facilities available.
- There will be no refreshments provided. A chorister should bring his/her own water bottle if required.
- Parents must collect choristers promptly at 6.40pm from the same door through which they entered the church.
- UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES CAN A CHORISTER ATTEND A REHEARSAL IF HE/SHE FEELS UNWELL, OR IF THEY OR A MEMBER OF THEIR HOUSEHOLD HAS TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID-19 AND/OR IS IN QUARANTINE.
